## **CROP UPDATE**

## WHAT IS KING BLOOM?

In each apple blossom cluster, the central flower, or "king bloom", is the first to open and often produces the largest, best-shaped fruit. We watch the king blooms closely to time pollination, thinning, and other key steps that set the stage for a great harvest. If you've ever noticed one apple on a branch that's a bit bigger and more perfect than the rest, it was probably a king bloom!

Thanks to a great spring and some well-timed frost protection (we ran our wind machines about seven times this year), we were able to preserve many of our "king bloom" apples. These apples tend to be larger and of higher quality, and this year, size and quality are both improved compared to last season.

Heavy thinning earlier in the year has also helped ensure larger, wellshaped fruit.

Summer has been mild overall, and so

with consistent watering and care, the apples have shown exceptional sizing when compared to warmer summers previously.

Volume is expected to be in line with prior years. However, we have been working harder than usual to manage fire blight, likely spread by bees during our longer-than-usual bloom period, and have been proactively removing affected branches to keep the trees healthy.

## APPLE TASTE PROFILES

**September Wonder\*** – Crisp and sweet with honey and citrus notes.

**Zestar\*** – Sweet and tangy with hints of brown sugar.

**Empire** – Juicy and crisp, balanced sweet-tart flavor.

**Ruby McIntosh** – Firm, crisp, and sweet-tart.

**Snappy McIntosh** – Spicy-sweet flavor. **Spartan** – Crisp texture with a sweet finish. **Red Delicious** – Sweet and crisp, a classic favorite.

**Snow Sweet**\* – Sweet with a hint of tartness and rich undertones.

**Winter Banana\*** – Tangy, juicy, and refreshing.

**Golden Delicious** – Exceptionally sweet. **Early Gold**\* – Sweet yellow-green, first harvested each fall.

**Week of October 6th** – First deliveries to stores (all routes). After that, Bozeman and Kalispell deliveries will alternate every other week and Missoula deliveries will occur weekly.





All varieties in our storefront are available in 5 lb. bags, 1/2 bushel (+/- 20 lbs.), and full bushel boxes (+/- 40 lbs).
